CERTIFICATION – SWIFT GROW

On behalf of the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries (NSWDPI) I certify that the Swift Grow liquid fish manure fertiliser produced by Riverstone Fish Farm is free from pathogens and suitable for agricultural applications.

Riverstone Fish Farm is DPI certified for Recirculating Aquaculture Systems (RAS). Effluent from RAS in rural areas is often used to irrigate and fertilise horticulture or pasture crops. River Stone Fish Farm processes the effluent through multiple stages and bottles it as plant food.

I base my certification on the analysis done by SWEP Analytical Laboratories which indicates that Swift Grow complies with DPI standards as safe to use on soils in NSW. Swift Grow liquid contains components that play a dual role of promoting healthy soil, and those same components also bio-suppress and helps control harmful micro-organisms/pathogens in soils. That dual role makes Swift Grow safe to use in soils in NSW and elsewhere.

The liquid and solid forms of Swift Grow fish manure fertiliser are compositionally identical and sourced from the same fish tanks in the same extraction process in the same farm. The liquid form is absorbed immediately by the soil, whereas the solid undergoes an extra drying stage to become slow release.
